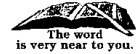

**BREAD UPDATES**

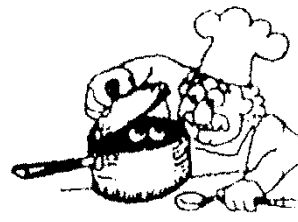
