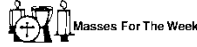

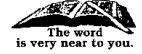

Tickets are \$9.00 for a dinner (2fish, bread, two sides) or \$6 for a sandwich (fish, bread).

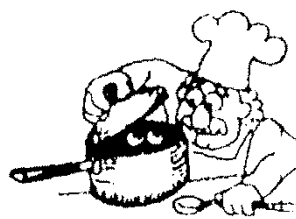
