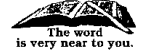

BREAD EVENTS

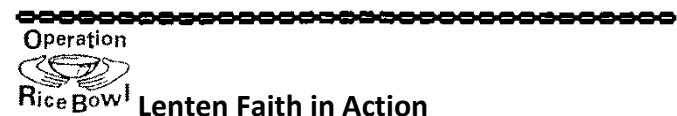
