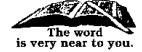
**Fiscal Year July 1, 2017 – June 30, 2018**

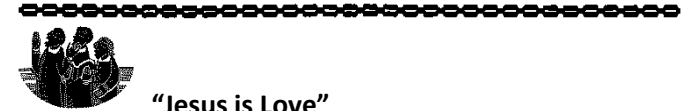
