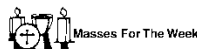

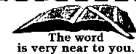

Eucharistic Ministers' Training – Saturday, August 17, in the Church from 10a.m. – 12:00 noon

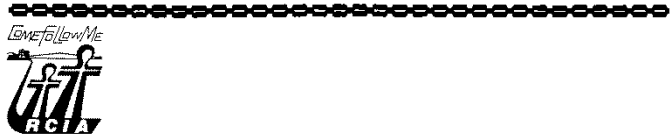
