Good day Church. Here is an update on repairs to the church and grounds as a result of the explosion, which happened on June 22, 2018.

The Catholic Diocese of Columbus assigned resources to work with insurance adjusters to assess repairs needed for all facilities on the church grounds. It was determined that the church and rectory were the only structures materially impacted by the explosion. The doors at the entrance of the church and the windows on the north side of the building required replacement. The resulting damage to the rectory rendered it structurally unstable and it would need to be demolished. Here is a short summary of the work that has been completed to date concerning these items.

General cleanup and removal of debris from the grounds of the church were completed immediately after the explosion. The doors at the entrance of the church were replaced and installed last year. The windows at the north end of the church were removed, replaced with plywood covers, the window fragments collected and all were sent to Associated Crafts Willet Hauser for restoration. Associated Crafts is located in Winona Minnesota and specializes in stained glass window restoration. This work is very tedious and takes a long time to complete. They are more than half way through the project and should be completed by year-end. The stairs at the front entrance were not included in the original claim but the Parish Council will review the impact to the stairs with the Diocese to see if it can be included.

The demolition of the Rectory consisted of capping of the sewer lines and inspection, AEP meter removal, HVAC removal, and working with a Demolition contractor to bring the building down. The contractor then removed the debris from the site. A lawn company then covered the ground with dirt and planted grass. The demolition work on the rectory is complete.

The Parish Council will update the timeline of window restoration if necessary.
