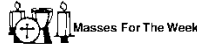

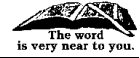

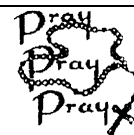

Bishop's Annual Appeal

Dear St. Dominic Parishioner,

The Bishop's Annual appeal began July 12, and you are invited to support the essential ministries and shared services of the Diocese.
