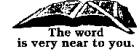

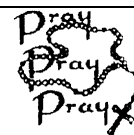

Mass Time: Please note St. Dominic has only one mass on Sundays at 11:30 a.m.

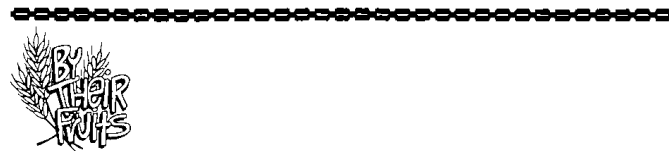
Adoration: Adoration will be at St. Dominic on Tuesday October 20, 2020 at 5 to 6pm.
