

This Evangelization program is aimed to carry the Gospel message to tribal people who live in rural areas and are deprived of the necessities like clean water, electricity, proper housing, education, healthcare, and sanitation. The tribal people have their own dialect and only to speak without a script. Priests, religious and a team of laity leaders are actively involved first to learn the dialect of the tribal and then catechize and promote education for children in this area.
