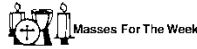

Real Presence, Real Future reflections: Seeing God in All Creation Fr. Michael Hartge, Moderator of the Curia, Diocese of Columbus

In the many Parish Consultation Sessions, I was privileged to be part of, many asked questions like, and "If we're expecting some shrinking of parishes, where is the effort to raise up the vocations and leaders we need?" That effort starts in the domestic family and is ultimately for the benefit of the family of the Church. When families are healthy, centered on Jesus, and supported to live their faith, the Church will be healthy.

Last year on the Feast of the Holy Family, Pope Francis recommended three words or phrases that should be common in all families, "please, thank you, and I'm sorry." This is just as relevant to our Church family as we review over 1,000 pieces of feedback from our Parish Consultation Sessions and continue to engage in dialogue about our future. In today's gospel, we hear that Mary kept the things Jesus said and did in her heart where she pondered them. Do we not think Our Blessed Mother is doing likewise with us?
