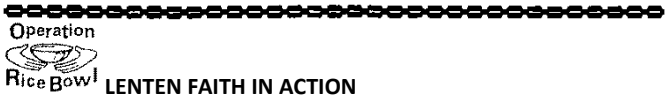

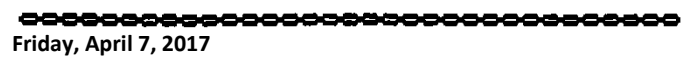
Lenten Challenge
