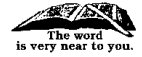

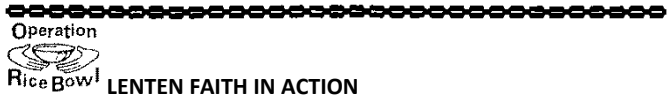

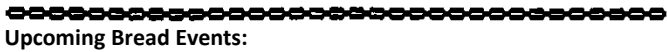
LENTE FAITH IN ACTION
