St. Dominic had a good representation of the over 2,200 people from different faiths who came together to demand justice at the Nehemiah Action on May 9. We celebrated some big victories around healthcare and mental health, got some promising commitments around a municipal ID card and a priority hiring ordinance, and challenged our mayor to support a different kind of economic strategy that would build wealth in our low-income communities such as Linden and the Hilltop.
